## **About the CGES Research Collaboratives and Graduate Fellowships:**

In the Center's aim to educate the next generation of scholars and researchers at the post-secondary level in fields relating to German and European Studies, the CGES supported numerous students through competitive fellowships which financed students' tuition costs and provided the students with a monthly stipend. These fellowships were associated with the Research Collaboratives. CGES offered other forms of support to graduate and undergraduate students pursuing dissertation or other research through travel grants and Bonn fellowships.
